The Israel Gerontological Data Center (IGDC) was created as a means for pooling existing sources of knowledge and for enriching available data in order to both expand the infrastructure of gerontological research and to make it available and accessible to interested parties. The IGDC provides a comprehensive bibliographic database and up-to-date statistical tables, as well as harmonized and linked databases. The Center also coordinates SHARE-Israel, (The Israeli component of the Survey of Health, Aging and Retirement in Europe). The aim of the IGDC is to stimulate increased study of population aging.



The IGDC was founded by the Ministry of Science and Technology and is supported by the Israeli Ministry for Senior Citizens. The SHARE-Israel project has been supported by the National Insurance Institute of Israel, the Ministry of Science and Technology, the NIA, GIF, the 7th framework program of the European Union and the Israeli Ministry for Senior Citizens.
